

- helping to mobilise material and financial resources to carry out the various proposed activities;

The diaspora volunteer will also need to work with staff made available by MINJEC, particularly with regard to:

- determining the camp's operating procedures;
- planning, reporting and monitoring and evaluation of activities;
- mobilising and managing local and diaspora experts;
- presenting catering menus and their arrangements;
- defining the levels of involvement of partners and other stakeholders;
- finding solutions to the needs of camp participants;
- identifying areas requiring attention to be brought before the Minister of Youth Affairs and Civic Education, accompanied by appropriate proposals.

IV. DURATION OF VOLUNTARY COMMITMENT

The diaspora volunteer recruited for this initiative shall be required to sign a Volunteer Engagement Contract, in accordance with the provisions of Law No. 2021/015 of 9th July 2021 to lay down the organisation and promotion of Volunteering in Cameroon, for a period of two (02) months, comprising one (01) and a half month for preparations and two (02) weeks for implementation, i.e. from 20th June to 20th August 2026.

V. CANDIDATE'S PROFILE

The Diaspora Volunteer must be a professional of Cameroonian origin, from the business world, currently living abroad or having lived abroad, and wishing to offer practical support for the organisation of the 2026 edition of CINA-JEDI. He or she must also possess a high degree of humility, empathy and the ability to listen, as well as a genuine desire to help others benevolently. As such, he/she must:

- demonstrate experience in event organisation;
- have a proven track record of success in the field of event management;
- be open to criticism and to sharing experiences;
- act with passion in all circumstances;
- be available at the chosen venue for the duration of the Camp;
- have a good mastery of the country's official languages (French and/or English);
- showcase a sense of responsibility;
- showcase good team spirit;
- have a network of contacts enabling them to mobilise the skills of Cameroonian youths at home and in the diaspora for the success of CINA-JEDI 2026;
- be proficient, where necessary, in one of the national vernacular languages of Cameroon's four (04) cultural spheres.

VI. COMPOSITION OF THE APPLICATION FILE

The application file shall include the following documents:

- a duly-filled application form, which can be downloaded from the Support Programme for the Return and Integration of Diaspora Youths (PARI-JEDI) website at www.parijedi.org, or the National Youth Observatory (NYO) website at www.onjcameroun.cm, or obtainable from the PARI-JEDI National Coordination Office in Yaounde at the 'Nlongkak'

neighbourhood, or from the Regional and Divisional Delegations of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Civic Education;

- a letter of motivation duly signed and stamped by the applicant.
- A detailed curriculum vitae (CV) of the applicant;
- a copy of the highest qualification or any other document substantiating the candidate's event management experience;
- Any formal evidence to support the information contained in the candidate's CV;
- the choice of commissions in which the candidate would like to serve, namely the Marketing & Finance Commission, the Reception, Accommodation & Logistics Commission, the Programming & Educational Content Commission, the Arts & Culture Commission, the Visits & Excursions Commission, the Health, Safety & Wellbeing Commission, the Communication & Engagement Commission, and the Monitoring, Evaluation & Reporting Commission, the tasks of which are set out in the application form;
- proof of their current or previous stay abroad.
